## INVESTMENT PHILOSOPHY

We believe if we invest in companies that uphold Catholic values, exhibit financial strength and above-average growth and whose shares appear undervalued, our portfolio will deliver attractive returns.

We strive to identify high quality, undervalued growth companies that maintain or exhibit the tenets put forth in the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' *Socially Responsible Investment Guidelines*. We overlay socially responsible investing parameters that protect human life and dignity, promote environmental well-being and encourage corporate responsibility. The portfolio targets 45 holdings with 1-5% (or benchmark weight) average position sizes and seeks diversification through all market capitalizations, up to 15% international stock exposure and within 5% (+/-) of its benchmark in any one economic sector. We target cash to be no more than 10% of our holdings. Through a disciplined investment process, flexible portfolio construction and rigorous sell discipline, we thoughtfully manage risk.

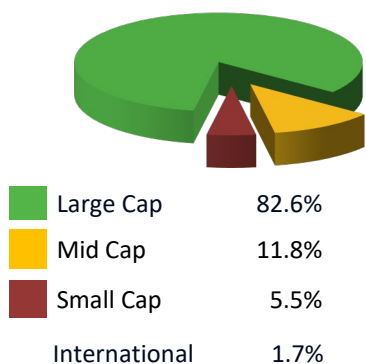

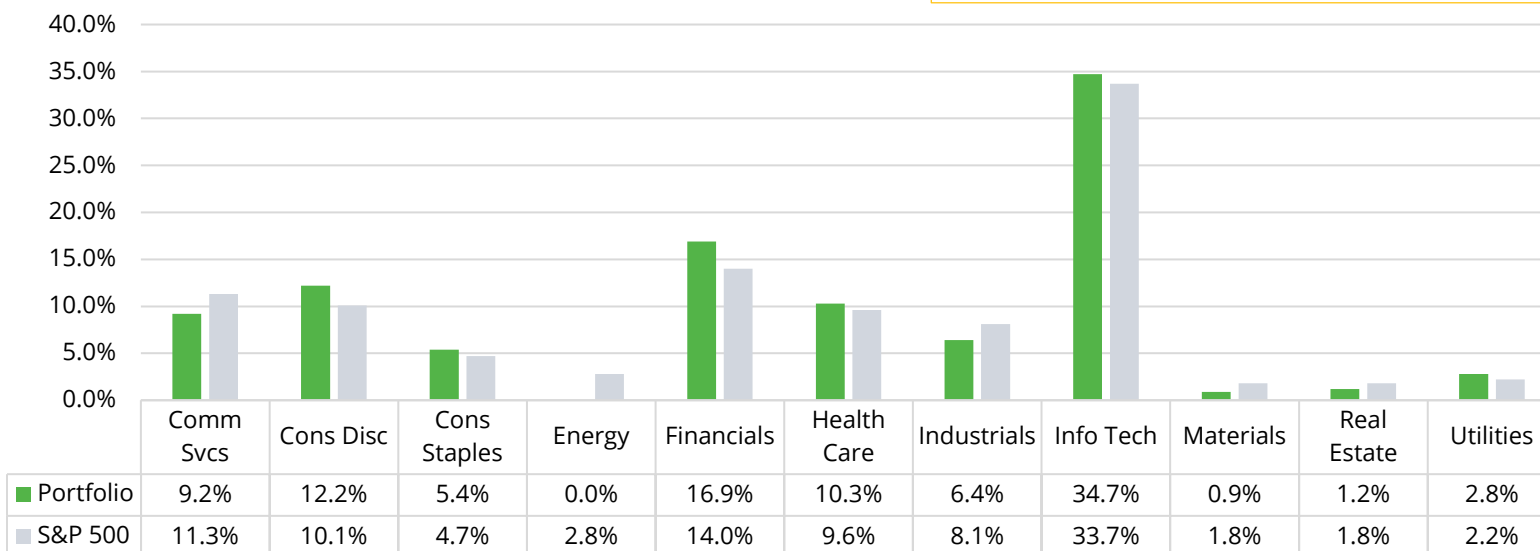

## Terms:

**Price-to-estimated earnings ratio** is a stock's price divided by its estimated after-tax earnings for the forward-looking 12-month period, which serves as an indicator of value based on earnings.

**Price to Sales ratio** is a valuation ratio that compares a company's stock price to its revenues.

**Price to Cash Flow Ratio** is a valuation metric calculated by dividing the company's stock price by its free cash flow. Free cash flow is measured by subtracted capital expenditures from operating cash flow.

**PE to Growth Ratio (PEG)** is a stock's price-to-earnings ratio divided by the estimated 3 year forward growth rate of its earnings.

**Total Debt-to-Total Capital** is measured by dividing the total debt of a company (short and long-term obligations) by the sum of the shareholders equity plus debt. Shareholders equity includes common stock, preferred stock, minority interests and net debt.

**Large Cap** is used to define the universe of stocks with a market capitalization of greater than \$10 Billion. **Mid Cap** is used to define the universe of stocks with a market capitalization of between \$2 billion and \$10 billion. Market capitalization is calculated by multiplying the number of a company's shares outstanding by the company's price per share.

**Carbon Emissions:** A weighted average of the strategy's underlying company carbon dioxide equivalent (CO<sub>2</sub>e) emissions as measured in thousands of metric tons for the latest fiscal year reported. CO<sub>2</sub>e data is provided by MSCI ESG research and captures scope 1 (direct) and scope 2 (indirect) emissions.

**Carbon Intensity:** A weighted average of the strategy's underlying company CO<sub>2</sub>e intensity. Intensity is a normalized metric that measures the tons of CO<sub>2</sub>e produced to generate \$1 million in sales.
